


St. Croix Falls is proud to be an official Ice Age Trail Community!



Hike-Through the St. Croix Falls Segment: 9 miles

*Remember to follow the yellow blazes to stay on the Ice Age Scenic Trail!

Interstate State Park – WI

Glacial Pothole Trail

Start at the Western Terminus inside Interstate Park – WI at the Glacial Pothole Trail. Take the trail counterclockwise. Be sure to stop at the Western Terminus trail marker overlooking the St. Croix River. Follow the loop back to the starting point.

Horizon Rock Trail

Cross the park road from the Glacial Potholes trail and enter Horizon Rock Trail. Follow trail through woods and past the stone shelter. Pass by the Visitor Center and enter the Skyline Trail.

Skyline Trail & Skyline Interpretive Trail

Progress on the Skyline Trail until you see the left turn for the Skyline Interpretive Trail. Exit the Skyline Interpretive Trail and meet up with the Park Entrance Road. Follow the paved bike trail (Interlink Trail) that parallels WI-35 to go towards St. Croix Falls. Cross under the Hwy 8 bridge and into the Hospital Esker Trail parking lot.

St. Croix Falls City Trails

Hospital Esker Trail

Enter the Hospital Esker Trail and follow the trail to the State Street hospital parking lot. From there, turn north on Roosevelt Street, and then East on Kentucky Street. Enter into the woods traveling first east, then southeast through a bluff area until connecting to a paved bike trail (Interlink Trail) on school grounds. Follow the Interlink trail and cross Blanding Woods Road to enter the Florence Baker Riegel Memorial Park.

Florence Baker Riegel Memorial Park

Follow the trail northeast through the Florence Baker Riegel Memorial park until you reach Fairgrounds Road. Cross Fairgrounds Road and follow the trail up a ridge to the intersection of Oregon Street and Sunrise Road. Take a left on Oregon, then a right and cross through an open field. Re-enter the woods and enter into Ray Zillmer Park.

Ray Zillmer Park

Follow the trail through Ray Zillmer Park to the Day Road parking lot. Cross Day Road and enter into the Mindy Creek Segment.

Mindy Creek Segment

Traverse the Mindy Creek segment until you reach State Road 87, passing through the entrance of the Wert Family Nature Preserve. Cross WI-87 and enter into St. Croix Falls Lions Park. The Indianhead Segment entrance is to your far right.

Indianhead Trail

Enter into the woods and follow the trail until you reach River Road, which is the end of the St. Croix Falls Segment. If you wish to hike through to the next segment, you can follow the 4.5 mile connecting route.

Connecting Route to the Gandy Dancer Segment: Take a right on River Road, turn south on WI-87, and then take a left on 160th Avenue until you reach the Gandy Dancer Segment. The start of the segment is where the Gandy Dancer State Trail crosses at 160th Avenue between 200th Street and Central Avenue.
